





Major milestones

- Retired FSRs.gov, and consolidated all subaward reporting data and functionality into [SAM.gov](https://sam.gov).
- Migrated the first two groups of entity registration modules into modernized SAM, enabling the FAR overhaul.
- [FPDS.gov](https://fpds.gov) report functionality was migrated to [SAM.gov](https://sam.gov), and we are finalizing the migration of contract awards data and search capabilities.
- [eSRS.gov](https://esrs.gov) subcontracting capabilities will transition to [SAM.gov](https://sam.gov) on an incremental basis with a primary release expected this year

Overview

The Contract Awards API allows users to request revealed Award and IDV contract data, and unrevealed Award and IDV contract data, based on the user's account and/or system account accessing the Contract Awards API.

Award and IDV contract data consists of:

- Delivery/Task Orders
- Government-Wide Agency Contracts
- Basic Ordering Agreements
- Blanket Purchasing Agreements
- Indefinite Delivery Contracts
- Other Transaction IDVs
- Federal Supply Schedules
- Purchase Orders
- Definitive Contracts
- BPA Calls
- Other Transaction Orders
- Other Transaction Agreements

Revealed/Unrevealed Data

Revealed data includes contracts that were either funded or awarded by a Civilian Subtier, as well as contracts funded and awarded by DoD, provided the Date Signed is at least 90 days prior to today's date. Unrevealed data consists of all revealed contracts, plus DoD contracts that were funded and awarded with a Date Signed less than 90 days prior to today. Additionally, the UEI and Name for the Immediate Parent and Domestic Parent of the Awardee is included in the Unrevealed API response and excluded from the Revealed API response.

Key Features of the Contract Awards API

- It offers several optional search parameters, filtering by sections, AND (&), OR (-), NOT (!) conditions, null searches, and a free text search q to obtain the desired data.
- It returns synchronous responses.
